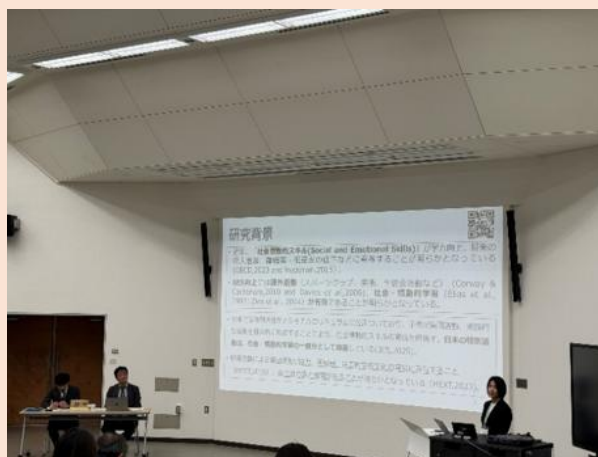

4月18～19日に鳴門教育大学で開催された日本アフリカ教育学会第37回大会で博士課程前期2年の千田成美さんが「優秀発表賞」を受賞しました。

受賞研究発表の題目は「マラウイ共和国における日本型特別活動による児童の社会情動的スキルへの影響」です。本研究の調査は、2026年1月下旬から3月中旬にかけてマラウイ都市部の小学校において日本の特別活動（日直、スピーチ、大縄、掃除等）を約1ヶ月間実施しました。本学会ではこれらの活動が児童の忍耐力や協力といった社会情動的スキル（非認知能力）にどのように影響を及ぼすかを分析した結果を発表し、その育成過程に着目した点が評価されました。今後も、児童の社会情動的スキルの変容やマラウイの文化に即した実践に向けて、さらに分析を深めていく予定です。



On April 18–19, Ms. Narumi Senda, a second-year master’s student, received the Excellent Presentation Award at the 37th Annual Conference of the Japan Society for Africa Educational Research, held at Naruto University of Education.

The title of the award-winning research presentation was “Effects of Japanese Extracurricular Activities on Students' Social-emotional Skills in Malawi.” In this study, Japanese-style special activities, such as daily class duties, speeches, long-rope jumping, and cleaning activities, were implemented for approximately one month at primary schools in an urban area of Malawi from late January to mid-March 2026.

At the conference, Ms. Senda presented the results of her analysis of how these activities affected children’s social and emotional skills, also known as non-cognitive

skills, such as perseverance and cooperation. Her presentation was highly evaluated for its focus on the process through which these skills are developed. She plans to continue deepening her analysis of changes in children's social and emotional skills and to further explore practices appropriate to Malawi's cultural context.
